American Cranes & Transport's 17th annual **ACT100**

Index of North America's top crane-owning companies.

The **ACT100** index of North America's top crane-owning companies declined in 2022, the first time in a long time that our index has not grown. There's been a sell off of cranes by most companies on the list, most notably by Maxim Crane Works, still the number one company on the list for 17 years running.

Maxim's index dropped from 715,000 tons to 261,743 tons. Maxim's total tonnage fell by 453,257 tons. The entire **ACT100** index shrank by 329,339 tons. While a lot of companies right-sized their fleets, a few made notable gains. For the most part, the top 10 companies still ranked in the top 10 with Buckner HeavyLift moving up two spots and a couple of companies in the top 10 trading places.

Companies in the top 10 that saw growth in their *ACT* index included Bigge, Buckner, Marmon and TNT. Last year, the **ACT100** added

89,917 tons for a total index of 2,868,110. In 2020, the **ACT100** gained 159,537 tons of capacity for a total index of 2,778,193.

This year the number of branches increased to 784, up 24 from 760 last year. Last year employee counts fell, but this year saw gains to the highest employee count ever recorded by the **ACT100**. In 2022, the **ACT100** employs 41,032 people. In 2021, the **ACT100** employed 36,987 workers. Employee counts of the **ACT100** have ebbed and flowed over the past five years.

In 2021, our index reported 3,288 crawler cranes. This year our index showed 3,129 crawler cranes.

This year there were 15,557 mobile cranes reported on our list as compared to 16,351 mobile cranes in 2021.

Mergers and acquisitions continue to impact the **ACT100**, although the activity wasn't as extreme as past years.

The top 25 stayed pretty much the same, with a few flip-flops here and there. The largest new company to enter

the **ACT100** is Allegiance Crane & Equipment, with an *ACT* index of 26,599 tons and a ranking of number 23.

The largest crawler crane fleet in North America goes to Lampson International this year with 393 crawler cranes. Maxim Crane Works reported 389 crawlers in their fleet, down from 515 last year. Maxim still has the largest mobile crane

fleet with 1,750 units, down from 2,850 mobile crane units in 2021.

The largest crane on the **ACT100** is Mammoet's 5,000-ton capacity PTC 200 DS and Sarens' SGC-250, both with 5,000 tons capacity. Other heavy lift cranes include the 3,000-ton capacity Lampson LTL-3000 and the Deep South Crane and Rigging VersaCrane TC36000/2.

Our methodology

For this list we sent surveys to close to 500 companies in the U.S., Canada and Mexico. While the **ACT100** is much more comprehensive than it was when we started it in 2005,

we realize there are probably 10 to 15 major crane-owning companies not represented. Some companies do not want to share information about their current fleets, and we respect their decision.

This year, we were 100 percent with 105 companies submitting forms. Due to ties, there are a few companies on the list with an asterisks and their data are shown as estimates. For these entries, we did not get updated information and instead relied on an estimate formula based on data obtained last year and through other sources. All these companies on the list were contacted, some several times, and given the opportunity to supply fleet information and related data.

As stated previously, in the largest crane in a fleet category, different capacities may be listed for the same machine. We rely on the information supplied to us in determining these capacities as rigging variables can change the capacity of the crane.

Because the vast majority of crane-owning companies are privately held, it can be difficult to obtain and verify figures, although we do approach independent industry sources for assistance and use related web resources and research when we use an estimate.
